CHARLES S. NOBLE JUNIOR "A" HOCKEY SCHOLARSHIP

The Charles S. Noble Scholarships honour the agricultural entrepreneur, innovator and farm implement manufacturer who became one of Alberta's biggest and best grain farmers.

The Charles S. Noble Junior "A" Hockey Scholarships reward the athletic and academic excellence of Junior "A" Hockey players and provide an incentive and means for these players to continue with their post-secondary education. Ten awards are available valued at \$1,000 each.

This scholarship is co-sponsored by the Alberta Heritage Scholarship Fund and the Alberta Junior "A" Hockey League.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

In order to qualify a student must be:

- an Alberta resident as defined by Alberta Heritage Scholarship Regulations;
- a participant, or have been a participant, in at least one full season of hockey in the Alberta Junior "A" Hockey League and have played during the last year or are currently playing;
- enrolled as a full-time student at a post-secondary institution in Alberta;
- achieved a minimum g.p.a. of at least 65% in the previous semester of study;
- recommended by the Scholarship Committee of the Alberta Junior "A" Hockey League.

Awards will be given to Alberta residents attending Alberta universities, colleges and technical institutes.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Nominations from each Junior "A" Hockey Team in Alberta are forwarded to the Scholarship Committee. Each nomination must include a current transcript and attachments outlining the applicants extra curricular activities and future goals.

The Committee will select recipients based on academic standing, community involvement and hockey achievements.

The deadline for submission of applications is December 1.
